The Situation/Problem

Mike Laccinole and Michelle Longmuir Wilkes, two Speech Language Pathologists (SLPs) at PeopleFirst Rehab commented how limited functional intervention tools were for dementia therapy and how they were required to piece together activities from different workbooks to try and meet the rehabilitative needs of their clients.
